This prestigious award is proudly named in memoriam of Betsy Ann Reynolds whose contributions at Manatt, Phelps & Phillips helped further the litigation support profession.

Betsy Ann joined Manatt in 1995 as Manager of Word Processing, and over the next 12 years worked her way up to Director of Software Solutions and Practice Support. She was instrumental in bridging the gap between various support services departments and Manatt's 300+ attorneys.

Betsy was an active member of ILTA and a popular speaker at their annual conference. She also contributed articles to industry publications on a variety of litigation support topics.
